MINUTES OF ICCOBA NA BOARD OF TRUSTEE MEETING SATURDAY APRIL 15, 2023

The president Mr. Sunday Uwumarogie called the meeting to order at 7.15pm CST. In attendance at this meeting were the following members

OPENING

The President welcomed members and thanked everyone for attending. He asked Dr. Vincent Oganwu to say the opening prayer. The minutes of the October 8, 2022, was read and upon a motion by Dr. Osagiede, seconded by Mr. Asemota, was adopted with the correction of the date of the meeting to October 8, 2022, and Mr. Benson Asemota to Mr. Asemota.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT/FOCUS OF THE MEETING

The President announced that the meeting will focus on the following:

2023 CONVENTION: He announced that the Dallas LOC have secured a hotel and posted the details of the hotel in the WhatsApp platform. The hotel room price per night is \$139.00 and the cutoff date is June 23, 2023.

STRATEGY TO FACILITATE CONVENTION ATTENDANCE AND SELL BROCHURE

ADVERTISEMENT. The President said the meeting will be dedicated to discussing strategies to do better with Convention Registration and sale of Brochure Advertisement. He noted that these are the two areas that the association can drive up income for our conventions. He hopes for advert to at least bring in a minimum of \$5000 for the Dallas Convention.

CONVENTION REPORT AND END OF YEAR FINANCIAL REPORT: The President again apologized for the delay in the Atlanta Convention Report which, also caused the delay in the End of Year for 2022. He stated that the delay was because of the lack of documents from the LOC in Atlanta. As a result, the financial team and the Executive used the pre-convention budget request amount provided by Fidel Cole to prepare the final report which has been presented to the BOT and the General House.

ELECTION OF NEW EXECUTIVE. The President brought to the attention Of the BOT members that, the term in office of the present Executive Committee, will end at the Convention and that the association will be conducting a general election and solicited the input of the BOT members in the election process.

SCHOLARSHIP REPORT. The president said that the association was able through the cooperation of the Principal of ICC and the committee he set up, award eight scholarship of 462,000 Naira each to students to cover their second and third terms. He said that the first term already passed as of the time of the award.

TREASURER'S REPORT.

The treasure, Mr. Osagie reported that after the income and expenditure for the period, the Association has a balance of \$52, 460.95 in the account as reflected in the Bank Statement he presented.

FINANCIAL SECRETARY'S REPORT

The Financial Secretary, Mr. Morrison Osifo, expressed regrets over the lateness of the Atlanta Convention Report, stating that it was due to the lack of transactions data from the LOC in Atlanta. He confirmed that the convention made a profit of \$1210.00. He informed the BOT of the decision of the Financial Team to henceforth, be responsible for paying the local vendors for Convention expenditures. This will ensure accurate and timely analysis and report to the BOT and the General House.

He reported a total of \$74,016.68 as the End of year Income for 2022 and thanked the BOT for their generous contributions which, he said, made the Association achieve its goals and objectives. He also said that he believes the BOT diligence in Contributing to the Association is having a positive impact on the dues paying habit of members.

The President, reacting to the report pointed out the alignment of the FS report, the Treasurer's statement, and the Bank Statement as a sign of our great financial health. Dr. Agho observed the non-inclusion of the funds that were raised for our brothers challenged by health issues. The FS explained that it has been previously accounted for in a separate document to the BOT and the House.

OLD BUSINESS:

The President explained how to understand the End of Year report as it concerns the BOT donation and stated that the BOT has already donated \$10,090.00 towards 2023.

NEW BUSINESS

Convention:

The President informed the BOT that Dr. Ehigie Omorodion is leading the LOC in Dallas and that he has secured the Hotel with a cutoff date of June 23, 2023. He said that he was informed that there will be a raffle ticket sale, which will be distributed to all chapters. The President again appealed to all members to buy Advert page in the Convention Brochure at the cost of \$100 for full page, \$75 for half page. He also reminded members of the convention fees, Double \$150, single \$100 and children \$40. He emphasized that these are the areas that can generate income for the convention to make profit or at least break even.

MATTERS ARISING

Mr. Asemota thanked the executive committee for Analysis based report and wants the committee to do away with events that are unprofitable for the association, like Merchandise sales. Dr. Imafidon believes we must take a close look at the methodology for sales. The use of WhatsApp platform was suggested, and the President promised to look at the suggestion.

Dr Arasomwan reported having trouble with opening the Dues Payment Chart. It appears the problem is not widespread, and the President will look into it.

Chief Inneh, updated the BOT members about the impending formation and inauguration of the Canada Chapter. They already have a WhatsApp platform with 38 members and are meeting soon. Dr Osagiede congratulated Chief Inneh and advised that, the President attends their inaugural meeting. Mr. Asemota supported the idea and said the association should pay for the President to attend.

Dr. Osagiede informed members of the impending marriage of the daughter of Ex President, Engr. Mathew Odigie in June 2023.

ADJOURMENT

Upon a motion for adjournment by Dr. Arasomwan and seconded by Dr. Osagiede, the meeting ended.
