Keynote Speaker -Bio

Ben Omorogbe is a nationally respected attorney who's been in practice for almost 30 years. He is one of the few attorneys admitted to practice before the United States Supreme Court. He has been honored multiple times as a Super Lawyer – an

honor that's generally bestowed on less than five percent of all lawyers practicing in a state.

Ben is currently the Group General Counsel for The Travelers Companies, the second largest business insurance company in the United States. In that capacity, he is responsible for the legal, regulatory and compliance functions of the company's economic and trade sanctions compliance, product development, coverage analysis and risk control operations in the United States, Canada, United Kingdom, Brazil and Colombia. He is the past Chairman of the American Insurance Association Committee on Economic Sanctions and the current Chairman of the American Property Casualty Insurance Association Financial Sanctions Committee. Before joining Travelers Companies in 2002, he was an attorney and partner in the national law firm of Gray Plant Mooty P.A. (now Lathrop GPM LLP), the oldest continuous law firm (formed in 1866) in Minneapolis, Minnesota. In 2001, he became the first African-American to become a partner in the firm's history. Prior to beginning his legal career, Ben was a Principal Analyst for the State of Minnesota Public Utilities

Commission.

Ben is a 1978 graduate of Immaculate Conception College (High School) in Benin City, Nigeria. He graduated with a Bachelor of Science degree from Southern University in Baton Rouge, Louisiana and an Master of Business Administration from Southeastern Louisiana University in Hammond, Louisiana. He earned his Juris Doctorate from The William Mitchell College of Law in St. Paul, Minnesota where he was the student body president and the recipient of the Student Award of Merit for his graduating class. Ben became one of the youngest persons to serve on the Board of Trustees of the William Mitchell College of Law starting in 2003. He also was as an adjunct professor and chair of the Academic Affairs Committee of the Board of Trustees of the law school. Ben was the first African-born chairperson of the Minnesota Council on Black Minnesotans when he was appointed by then Minnesota Governor Arnie Carlson in 1997 and reappointed by Governor Jesse Ventura in 1999. In his capacity as chair, he served as an advisor to the Governors as well as the Minnesota Legislature on the social and economic matters that impacted African Americans in the state. He has mentored dozens of lawyers and law students many of whom have become judges, law firm partners and business executives. He has received countless awards in the course of his career, including awards for Distinguished Service, Top In-House Counsel, Equal Justice and Executive of the Year. Ben continues to serve as a member of the board of directors for numerous business and civic organizations.

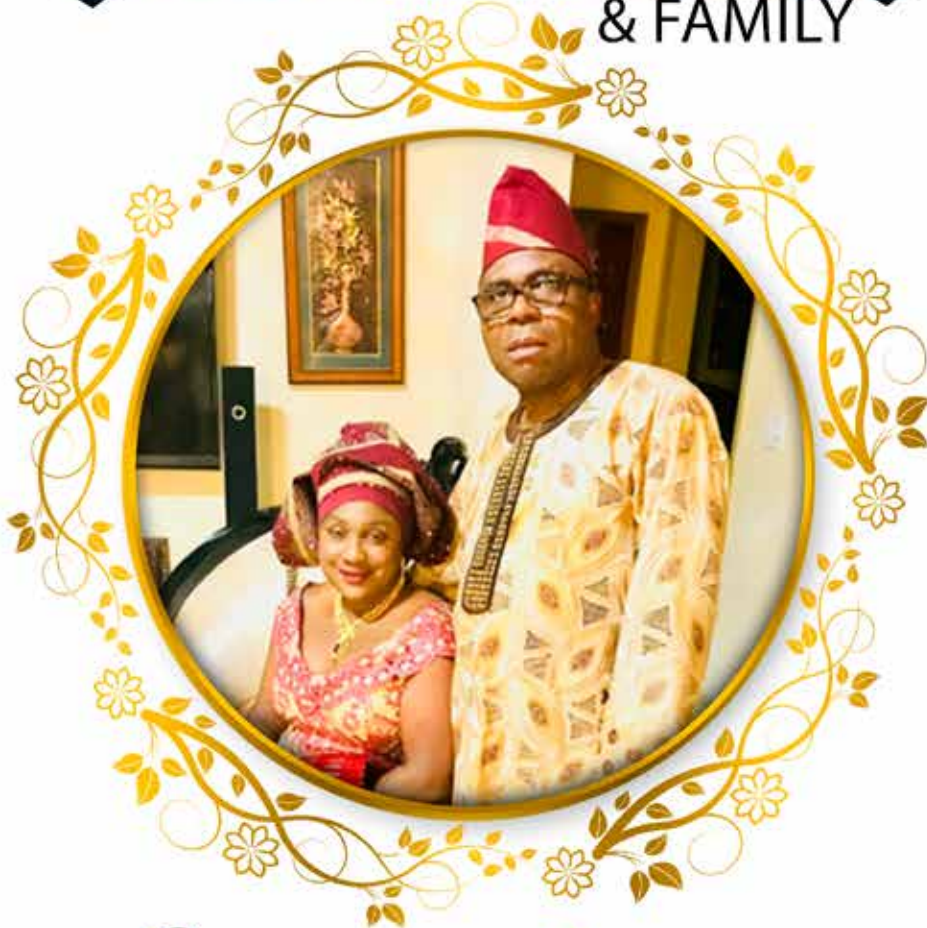

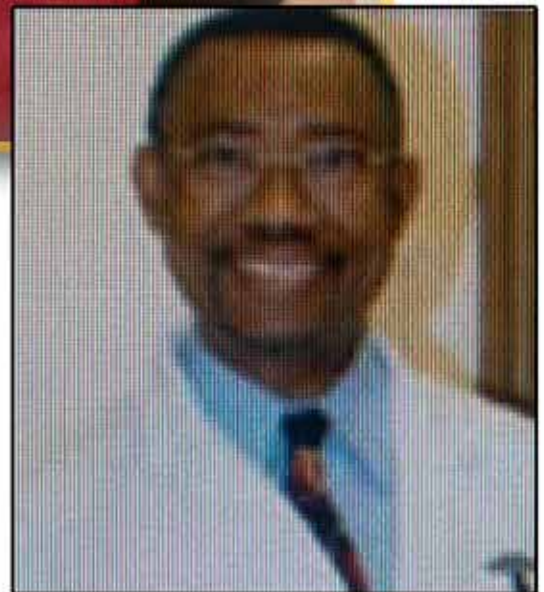
